Volunteer Opportunities

Intake – Interview clients seeking assistance, take down essential data, copy documentation of job loss, utility or rent delinquency notices, if any. Refer to resource and referral manager. Fifteen shifts available, three hours each, from Monday- Friday (9-noon; 11:30-2:30, 2-5)

Clothing Closet – sort through donations for suitability, shelve/ display according to age, gender, size. Distribute to clients. Five shifts available, 9-noon, Monday through Friday.

Food Pantry – sort through donations to ensure no spoilage, coordinate with Destin Harvest and other donors to ensure a balance of food offered. Distribute to clients. Five shifts available – 2-5, Monday through Friday.

Administrative Assistance – Answer phones, complete initial intake over the phone, enter data into computer data base. Five shifts available – 2-5, Monday- Friday.

Meals: Bring dinner for residents staying at Opportunity Place (no more than 16) once a month at 6 p.m.; Donate individual cereal boxes, juices for breakfast.

Transportation: Take clients to medical and legal appointments; inspect housing; job interviews: On-call.

Items Needed:

Bathroom cabinets; ceiling fans with lights; Clothes Hangers (in good shape); Coffee Tables; Towels and washcloths in good shape; paper goods (toilet paper, paper towels, tissues, paper plates, cups); pots, pans, serving trays for kitchen; FUNDS
